Make the content inspiring, scalable, and sharable.

Basic information

Include your name and co-presenter (if applicable) or list "Panel" if more than two presenters.





Presentation Title (max 60 characters) Make it catchy.

Presentation Description

(max 750 characters) Include learning outcomes, be descriptive, clear and engaging.





Topic for Presentation

What do you know? What have you tried? What can you share? Think of topics that other libraries can use and scale.

Target Audience

Is your topic intended for a specific audience or library type or applicable to all?





Check your spelling!

If selected, your submission will be posted EXACTLY as submitted.

BEST PRACTICES FOR VIRTUAL PRESENTATIONS



Practice. Engage. Have Fun!

When presenting in a virtual setting, presenters have to compete for their audience's eyes, ears, hearts, and minds against diminished attention spans, increased home, work and life distractions, and conflicting priorities. Here are some tips to keep your audience engaged.

- Choose the right background and lighting that highlight you, the expert, and not a distracting background.
- Practice with the technology ahead of time so you feel confident.
- Present with energy and animation, smile!
- Engage your participants by using micro-engagments and the tools already in Zoom; polls, voting, whiteboards, break-out rooms, icons and emojis.

Most importantly, be yourself and have fun! CLiC staff are ready and willing to help you practice and offer feedback.
